IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS:

Nurse Practitioner-Led Clinics (NPLCs): Since there is no SAR for NPLCs, we have a special award category - "**Shining NPLC Award**" - for the NPLC that completes the most cancer screenings (tracked through the EMR). NPLCs will also be eligible to win the awards indicated below with an "*".

AWARD CATEGORIES:

1. **Academy Award for Spotlight Office:** The office who has the biggest increase in cancer screening rates overall
2. **Humanitarian Award*:** The office member that goes above and beyond for the health and well-being of their patients. BY NOMINATION ONLY (Deadline Jan. 18, 2018)
3. **Breast Rising Star Award:** The office that shows the biggest improvement in breast screening rates
4. **Cervical Rising Star Award:** The office that shows the biggest improvement in cervical screening rates
5. **Colorectal Rising Star Award:** The office that shows the biggest improvement in colorectal screening rates
6. **The Red Carpet Award:** The office who has the biggest decrease in under/never screened patients (SAR triple-negative report)
7. **Best Supporting Practitioner Award*:** The practitioner that goes above and beyond for the health and well-being of their patients. BY NOMINATION ONLY (Deadline Jan. 18, 2018)
8. **Best Dressed Female*:** Will be selected at The OscSARs (Feb. 22, 2018) by the Regional Cancer Program
9. **Best Dressed Male*:** Will be selected at The OscSARs (Feb. 22, 2018) by the Regional Cancer Program
10. **Shining NPLC Award*:** The NPLC who completes the most cancer screenings
