Chronic Pain Management Assessment and Referral Program (CPMARP)

The CPMARP team will provide in depth pain assessment(s) to those persons suffering from chronic pain in the Erie St. Clair (ESC) district. Thorough pain assessments may be completed by one or more members of the team consisting of an Intake Registered Nurse, a Nurse Practitioner, an Occupational Therapist or a Social Worker. Together the team will collect the appropriate information and provide each referred client with effective and efficient pain assessments, treatment options, and recommendations for ongoing pain management in order to increase the client's quality of life.

Who is eligible to participate in this Program?

Clients must have non cancer-related pain, are not considered end of life (palliative comfort care) and be diagnosed with chronic pain greater than 3 consecutive months. Clients with a WSIB or motor vehicle accident claim are not eligible.

How can a client be a part of this program?

All clients must be referred to the CPMARP head office by their Family Physician. For a referral form, please contact 1.855.419.5200.

Where are clients assessed?

Upon receiving the Physician provided referral, clients will be contacted by the Intake RN by phone. The Intake RN will assess the client to determine which person on the team should continue on with assessment of the client's needs. Appointments will be provided for the client to be seen at a location closest to their residence. See *CPMARP Locations*.

Purpose?

The CPMARP's goal, in addition to providing proper and timely care to clients suffering from chronic pain, is to devise an inventory of services and to develop a gap analysis. This gap analysis will illustrate what services are lacking and what is needed across the ESC district for clients with chronic pain.
