## **INTRODUCING FIRST LINK TO HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS** **A program to help you care for your patients and families affected by** **Alzheimer's disease and related dementias**

### **What is First Link<sup>®</sup>?**

First Link is a program that connects individuals and families affected by dementia to opportunities for learning, community services and support throughout the course of the disease.

**A First Link referral will save you valuable time and energy.** It's simple – just fax a referral form and First Link will take it from there

- First Link will provide one to one support to your patients and families
- First Link will provide education about what to expect through the progression of the dementia and how to cope
- First Link makes sure individuals are connected to the appropriate resources in the community

Once the First Link is made, you will notice:

- **Fewer and less intense crises** impacting your patients and families
- Patients and families will be **more knowledgeable and prepared** with enhanced coping skills

Research tells us...

- The average delay in diagnosis from onset of first symptom is 2.5 to 3 years. The delay in seeking diagnosis is attributable to the lack of family recognition and/or family hesitance to seek help, as well as a lack of professional recognition.
- Only 23% of individuals with dementia are currently receiving medications used to alleviate symptoms of dementia.
- Over 50% of dementia cases are diagnosed beyond the mild stage. Earlier diagnosis facilitates earlier treatment with anti-dementia drugs and early family education and support. These interventions have all been shown to improve the situation for clients and caregivers and enables individuals to stay at home longer.
